

Classifier Requirements & Roles

NATIONAL CLASSIFIER

National Medical Classifier:

- Professional medical certification: physiotherapist, medical doctor, occupational therapist (or other medical professional with required knowledge of anatomy, physiology and pathology)
- Can issue New Status (N)
 classification cards to athletes in
 Canada

National Technical Classifier:

- Experienced and knowledgeable in competitive bowls: coach, umpire
- Can issue Temporary Status (T)
 classification cards to athletes in
 Canada

INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFIER

International Classifier Requirements & Roles:

- Appointed by the IBD Classification
 Committee from authorized National
 Classifiers who have conducted
 classifications in at least two IBD
 sanctioned international competitions
- Can act as instructors at classificiation seminars and train national classifiers.

Classification Status Cards:

 Can issue Review Status (R) and Permanent Status (P) classification cards
